Resolution EC 24-12

Title: Authorization to Apply for a Denali Commission Tribal Victims Services Program Grant

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 37,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, under Article X of the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Denali Commission has announced a Tribal Victims Services program grant; and

WHEREAS, the grant aims to support tribally driven service programs and address the need for enhanced physical infrastructure for Tribal Victims Services; and

WHEREAS, these funds may facilitate the attendance of current Public Safety staff to attend Emergency Communications and Amber Alert systems training which may enhance emergency response protocols; and

WHEREAS, this collaboration could extend to the behavioral health department for deploying clinicians to emergency events such as citizens who are either missing or murdered therefore bolstering support for the Missing or Murdered Indigenous People and Tribal Victim Services program initiatives; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida seeks to apply for up to \$350,000 in funds for a one-year project, including the full amount of Tlingit & Haida's federally approved indirect rate;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required by the Denali Commission for granting funds to Tlingit & Haida for the proposed project.

ADOPTED this 23rd day of February 2024, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 6 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 0 absences.
