## Executive Council of the Central Council TLINGIT & HAIDA INDIAN TRIBES OF ALASKA

Resolution EC 21-11

Title: Authorization to Engage as a Sub-Awardee for a Tribal-Researcher Capacity Building Grant

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 32,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, under Article X of the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida has identified as a priority the development of reentry programs and services to address the needs of citizens returning to the community from incarceration; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida has determined there is a need for research to establish the efficacy of tribally run housing, services and cultural programing for returning citizens; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida has developed a working partnership with the University of Alaska Anchorage (UAA) School of Social Work to engage in evaluation planning driven by tribal priorities and indigenous values; and

WHEREAS, producing evaluation data that is tribally-directed and tribally-driven will aid in securing future grants to fund reentry services; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida has been engaged as a sub-awardee in partnership with the UAA School of Social Work in applying for a Tribal-Researcher Capacity Building Grant for 2021 that will allow the two entities to develop a formal evaluation project;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required for the Tribal-Researcher Capacity Building Grant for 2021, acting as a sub-awardee, for granting funds to the UAA School of Social Work in partnership with Tlingit & Haida for the proposed project.

ADOPTED this 17<sup>th</sup> day of March 2021, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 6 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 0 absences.
