Resolution EC 21-36

Title: Authorization to Transfer Funds from Charles Schwab & Co. to Wells Fargo Bank

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 32,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, under Article X of the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida owns the Tribal Trust Fund bank account held at Charles Schwab & Co.; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida has an outstanding balance for the purchase of approximately 86 acres of land located on Douglas Island in Juneau, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida determined it would be in the best interest of the Tribe to pay off the remaining balance of the Douglas Island land purchase; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer recommends \$1,227,187 be transferred from the Tribal Trust Fund held at Charles Schwab & Co. to Wells Fargo Bank for the purpose of paying the balance on the Douglas Island land purchase;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby concurs with the recommendation of the Chief Financial Officer Theresa Belton to transfer \$1,227,187 from Charles Schwab & Co. to Wells Fargo Bank in order to pay the balance on the Douglas Island land purchase.

ADOPTED this 16th day of June 2021, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 5 yeas, 1 nay, 0 abstentions and 0 absences.
