Resolution EC 22-29

Title: Authorization to Apply for Head Start Cost of Living Adjustment and Quality Improvement Funds

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 34,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, under Article X of the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida has over 40-years of experience administering the Head Start program, providing children and families with quality early childhood educational services that promote school readiness; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Head Start has notified Tlingit & Haida it is eligible to apply for \$88,028 in Cost of Living Adjustment funds and \$13,635 in Quality Improvement funds totaling \$101,663 from the Office of Head Start, as authorized by the FY2022 Consolidated Appropriations Act; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to apply for up to \$101,663 in Quality Improvement and Cost of Living Adjustment funds from the FY 2022 Consolidation Appropriations Act; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required by the Office of Head Start for granting funds to Tlingit & Haida for the proposed Quality Improvement and Cost of Living Adjustment funds.

ADOPTED this 25th day of May 2022, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 5 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 1 absence.
