Resolution EC 23-44

Title: Authorization to Apply for U.S. Department of Justice Second Chance Act Community Based Reentry Grant

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 35,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, under Article X of the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida has identified as a priority the development of reentry programs and services to address the needs of citizens returning to the community from incarceration; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida provides reentry and recovery services that allow for safety, stability, and security for individuals returning to the community; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida's programming is grounded in culture-centered practices and Southeast Traditional Values; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice has announced funding through the Second Chance Act Community Based Reentry Program; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to apply for up to \$750,000 in funds, and such funding includes the full amount of Tlingit & Haida's federally approved indirect rate

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required by U.S. Department of Justice.


