## Resolution EC 23-68

Title: National Congress of American Indian Membership and Representation

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 36,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, under Article X of the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida wishes to continue membership in good standing with the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI); and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida meets all requirements for Tribal Membership, pursuant to Article II - Members, Section B(1) of the Constitution and By-laws of the National Congress of American Indians; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council hereby authorizes Tlingit & Haida's President Richard J. Peterson, who is the official principal tribal official, to take the necessary action to place the Tribe in membership in the National Congress of American Indians; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that tribal funds in the amount of \$1,300, based on the tribal membership dues schedule in the NCAI Bylaws, Article III - Members, Section C(2) are authorized to be paid for membership in NCAI; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that based on the active tribal roll of 3,000 citizens, the Tribe shall have 180 votes, in accordance with NCAI Bylaws, Article III - Members, Section B(1)(d); and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that pursuant to NCAI Constitution Article III – Executive Council, Section B, the Tribe designates the following persons as Delegate and Alternate Delegate(s), and instructs them to become individual members in good standing in NCAI in order to fulfill their responsibilities as Official Delegates to the National Congress of American Indians Annual Convention, Mid-Year Conference and Executive Council Winter Session, all for 2-year terms covering 2022-2024 or until they are replaced as Executive Council members:

- 2. Jackie Pata, 1<sup>st</sup> Delegate
- 3. Rob Sanderson, Jr., 2<sup>nd</sup> Delegate
- 4. Catherine Edwards, 3<sup>rd</sup> Delegate
- 5. Will Micklin, 4<sup>th</sup> Delegate
- 6. Clinton Cook, Sr., 5<sup>th</sup> Delegate
- 7. Delbert Kadake, 6<sup>th</sup> Delegate
- 8. Lauryn Framke, Emerging Leader
