Resolution EC 23-75

Title: Funding for Elizabeth Place Office Space

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 36,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, under Article X of the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida seeks funding to provide, furnish, and improve additional office space to Tlingit & Haida employees for the provision of programs, functions, services, and activities for the benefit of its Tribal citizens; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida has the capacity and willingness to provide financial support to itself as both Borrower and Lender from its Trust fund; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to provide, furnish, and improve additional office space for the benefit of its Tribal citizens with Trust funds to be later reimbursed; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida acknowledges the need to formalize the loan transaction to ensure proper accounting, accountability, and reimbursement;

Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments for Tlingit & Haida to loan itself, from its Trust fund, the principal amount of One Hundred Ninety-Five Thousand One Hundred Seventeen Dollars and Eleven Cents (\$195,117.11) (the "Loan Amount" or "Principal").

ADOPTED this 21st day of September 2023, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 5 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 1 absence.
