Resolution EC 25-06

Title: Authorization to Apply for Family Violence Prevention and Services Act Grant

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 38,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, under Article X of the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Administration on Children, Youth and Families; Family and Youth Services Bureau, has funding available under the Family Violence Prevention and Services Act; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida has partnered with Southeast Alaska Women's Shelters to provide services to women and children who are victims of domestic violence and sexual assault; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to apply for up to \$700,000 in funds from the Family and Youth Services Bureau for a two-year project, and such funding includes the full amount of Tlingit & Haida's federally approved indirect rate; and

WHEREAS, these funds would be used for advocate positions, awareness events and trainings;

ADOPTED this 24th day of January 2025, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 6 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 0 absences.
