Resolution TA 22-04

Title: Increasing Access for Jury Service

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 34,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska can summons you to serve jury duty if you are at least 18 years of age, an Alaskan resident for at least one year, a United States citizen, are of sound mind, possess normal abilities to reason, and are able to read or speak the English language; and

WHEREAS, an employer may not fire you, demote you or otherwise penalize you for jury service; and

WHEREAS, there is a system in place to document your jury service to share with your employer and minimum compensation of \$25 per day of service, beginning on the second day, and such compensation does not meet the threshold of minimum wage;

WHEREAS, an employer is not required to compensate an employee for lost wages due to jury service and a recent study has shown that more than 60% of Americans are living paycheck to paycheck; and

WHEREAS, lost income can be a hardship that impairs someone's ability to participate on a jury, that may prevent a person from receiving a "jury of their peers"; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Eighty-Seventh Tribal Assembly of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska delegation convened April 20-22, 2022, hereby supports increasing juror compensation to be in line with minimum wage requirements in the state of Alaska; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Tlingit & Haida will include this request for increased funding to the Alaska Legislature as one of the Tribe's priorities to support better access to fair trials.

ADOPTED this 20th day of April, 2022, by the Eighty-Seventh Tribal Assembly of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska.
