WHEREAS, the position provides young adults with opportunities to acquire important knowledge about Tlingit & Haida, its processes and organizational structure while acquiring valuable hands-on leadership experience; and

WHEREAS, the Emerging Leader has all rights of attendance at all Executive Council meetings and may speak on any business that is before the Executive Council;
