Resolution TA 22-11

Title: Child Care on Prince of Wales Island

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 34,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, Craig Child Care is the only facility that provides child care on Prince of Wales Island; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida serves 1,090 tribal citizens between the communities of Klawock and Craig; and

WHEREAS, Craig Child Care sent a letter to families announcing they are shutting down on April 15, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida acknowledges the need for child care; and

WHEREAS, this shutdown will impact the economic conditions on Prince of Wales Island because families will have to choose between working outside the home or staying at home;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Eighty-Seventh Tribal Assembly of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska delegation convened April 20-22, 2022, hereby commits to supporting the development of child care and the efforts to recruit and retain child care on Prince of Wales Island.

ADOPTED this 22nd day of April, 2022, by the Eighty-Seventh Tribal Assembly of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska.
