WHEREAS, a bill is being prepared for consideration in the Alaska State Legislature to establish a day each year as Alaska Native Veterans Day; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized Alaska Natives and American Indians comprise the highest amount of veterans per capita in our great country; and

WHEREAS, a bill in the Alaska State Legislature to establish a special day in the State of Alaska honoring our Alaska Native Veterans will give recognition to all Alaska Natives who have served, are serving and will serve in the United States military;
