Resolution TA 24-02

Title: Tlingit & Haida Cultural Ambassador

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 37,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, there has been a significant investment from the Tribe as well as our Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act (ANCSA) corporations and villages to revitalize our culture; and

WHEREAS, we do not currently have a competition to highlight the amazing advancement we have had that would feature our future generation's learning about our culture and where they come from, and owning it and revitalizing it; and

WHEREAS, there are competitions and pageants that highlight Alaska Native and American Indian culture and issues including Miss Cama-i and Miss Indian World, where the competitors refine their leadership skills; and

WHEREAS, there are several tribes and ANCSA corporations in Southeast Alaska that could partner to bring a cultural ambassador competition to Southeast;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Eighty-Ninth Tribal Assembly of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska delegation convened April 17-19, 2024, will explore the interest in creating a Tlingit & Haida Cultural Ambassador competition in the next 12 months and the cost to be presented for approval at the 2025 Tribal Assembly;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Tlingit & Haida will explore working closely with partners to host the competition at the same time as an existing cultural event;

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, the competition coordinators would review the Miss Indian World competition requirements and if the winner is eligible, provide the financial support for the winner to compete.


